TERMS OF REFERENCE : CHANGING FOR CHILDREN EXECUTIVE BOARD

Overall aim :

To ensure that Oldham Children's Trust is working effectively to produce the best possible outcomes for children, young people and families in Oldham.

1. To act as the accountable body holding all partners to account for the provision of high quality integrated services.
2. To unblock any barriers or blockages especially those related to resources affecting the outcome for children and young people.
3. To report to the Local Safeguarding Children Board on the welfare of all children and young people is paramount in all decision making.
4. To provide a direct strategic link between the Oldham Local Strategic Partnership , the Children, Young People and Families Executive Board, Stakeholder Partnership and the Changing for Children Strategy Group.
5. To monitor and evaluate the impact of the Children and Young People's Plan, and to offer advice as appropriate.
6. To ensure the effective partnership working and development required to ensure that the outcomes for Oldham's Children, Young People and Families are met, and to monitor this.
7. To secure agreement from the member's own partner organisation for all policy framework developments, and to advise on strategic direction and cultural change.
8. To monitor and evaluate the impact of commissioning, and to ensure that all services and provision meet the best value standards.
9. To monitor the involvement and engagement of children, young people and families in the design of services.
10. To provide final approval for submission re: inspections, reviews, submissions.
11. To oversee the implementation of the CYPP.
