What is fly posting?

Fly posting is putting up unauthorised posters and stickers, usually adverts, in public places.

Why is it a problem?

Fly posting is unsightly and spoils the environment. If it is not removed the posters slowly rot, becoming more unsightly and causing litter. In addition, the businesses involved are gaining an unfair advantage over their law abiding competitors by not paying for advertising space.

What we do about it

The Environmental Action Unit takes action against the people responsible for fly posting on the Highway and Street Furniture. We can issue £80 fixed penalty notices and have powers to prosecute both the people putting up the material and the businesses being advertised.
