## Who is this directory aimed at?

This directory contains contact details and general information about all the supported accommodation schemes, floating support and other services operating in Oldham that are funded through the Supporting People Programme.

You may find it useful if;

- You are in need of housing related support
- You know somebody who needs housing related support
- You work with vulnerable people and need information about services in Oldham

## Who can receive Supporting People Services?

The programme covers all people in Oldham who receive housing-related support services.

People who benefit from the Supporting People programme include -

- older people
- people with mental health needs
- people with a learning disability
- vulnerable young people
- people with drug or alcohol problems
- people who are offenders
- people who are homeless or at risk of losing their home
- people at risk of domestic violence.

## Do you have to pay to use a Supporting People Service?

You will not have to pay for a service offering short-term support (less than two years)

There is a charge for services offering long-term support (more than two years) but if you receive housing benefit to help pay for your rent you will not have to pay for this.

If you are on low income you may not have to pay for the service. You can choose to have a financial assessment to work out what, if anything, you have to pay. See Fairer Charging details in the contacts section at the back of the directory.

## What types of support do Supporting People services offer?

**Floating Support** – A support worker visits a person in his or her own home to support them to maintain their tenancy. Once they have established themselves in the community and are able to live independently the service moves to another client.

**Hostels** – A hostel is somewhere that people with no home can live for a short time.

**Warden / Visiting Support** – Sheltered housing with a warden who will have regular contact with tenants and an alarm for 24 hour cover in emergencies.

**24 Hour Supported Accommodation** – Support staff will be on-site 24 hours a day with either 'waking night' or 'sleep-in' cover over night. Often it is a shared house with communal living areas such as lounge and kitchen but it may also be a collection of self-contained flats within a larger building with staff accommodation alongside.

**Supported Accommodation with Visiting Support** – As above but tenants are visited on a regular basis by support staff .

**Refuge** – A refuge is somewhere people can go for protection or shelter. This type of service is usually available for women at risk of domestic violence or homeless people

**Home Improvement Agency** – Home improvement agencies provide advice and assistance with adaptations, improvements and repairs to property that enable older people to remain active, safe and independent in their own homes.

**Supported Lodgings** – Supported Lodgings are offered by private individuals in their home. In addition to somewhere to live they provide support to help the individual to gain independence.

### **What is housing-related support?**

The Supporting People programme does not cover all services people might consider to be support, but specifically focuses on support services that are related to ensuring people can continue to live safely and securely in their own home or develop skills to live more independantly. This sort of support includes:

- Offering people help with managing their budgets and accessing welfare benefits so they don't accrue rent arrears and ultimately lose their home;
- Offering people a generic service in their own home, tailored to their individual needs, similar to that offered to older people in sheltered housing, e.g. monitoring of well-being, community alarm, emotional support etc;
- Helping people to maintain their own safety in the home;
- Helping people to make and keep appointments, including going with them if necessary;
- Helping people to gain access to other services they may need, including training, further education, employment, health and social activities;
- Assisting people in planning their weekly meals, shopping and food preparation, but not doing it for them;

The above list is not exhaustive, but it shows the type of support services considered to be housing related. However, the Programme does not cover health and social care services such as Home Support, Community Meals, and Personal Care such as bathing, toileting etc. Nor does it cover housing management and maintenance duties.

### **What if someone needs more than housing related support?**

- People receiving a Supporting People service may receive other services as well.
- Many of the services listed in the directory receive other sources of funding to provide personal care etc.
- In addition to the services listed in this directory there are others that do not receive Supporting People funding, such as registered care homes. You may find the the contacts section at the back of the directory useful.

Support is provided to enable people to obtain, maintain and retain accommodation.</p> <p>Service users are allocated a Support Worker who can offer support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-information on a range of housing options and support services.</li> <li>-applying for appropriate accommodation.</li> <li>- support before, during and after a move.</li> <li>-budgeting.</li> <li>-daily living skills.</li> <li>-applying for benefits.</li> <li>-applying for employment/training.</li> <li>-accessing community facilities.</li> <li>-settling into the area that the service user has moved to.</li> <li>-gaining longer term support if required.</li> </ul> <p>All service users have an individual support plan which is agreed and tailored to their needs. The aim is to offer individuals a breathing space in a supportive environment and the opportunity to learn the skills required for independent living.</p> <p>Support will be offered by the Lodging Provider. Support will be in accordance to an individually tailored support plan.</p> <p>The support provided could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-budgeting</li> <li>-daily living skills</li> <li>-accessing education, training.</li> <li>-cooking,</li> <li>-shopping</li> <li>-emotional support.</li> <li>-accessing longer term support.</li> </ul>

<b>Service Description</b>	<p>Accommodation based service with flexible floating support. There are five KeyRing networks in Oldham, in Littlemoor, Fitton hill, Chadderton and Central Oldham.</p> <p>KeyRing does not own any property, but works in partnership with a local housing provider to help network members obtain their own tenancy in the network area.</p> <p>Each network has one Community Living Worker who is specifically recruited for their ability to support people locally and in a way which is flexible. The CLW supports 9 network members and lives within the network area. This enables support to be non-intrusive and available when a person needs and not when they don't.</p> <p>Network members will receive support in their own home or can visit the CLW at home. Full use is also made of community facilities as meeting places.</p> <p>KeyRing recognises that, though people have a variety of abilities and needs, all have a right to control their own lives in their own homes and are entitled to support which enables them to do so.</p> <p>KeyRing's focus is on the assets of individuals and the community and assisting people to reap the benefit of sharing those assets or gifts.</p>

Services are accredited by the National Autism Society.</p> <p>The scheme offers a range of types of accommodation and facilities, from shared houses to self-contained flats within houses and ground floor fully accessible rooms to first floor rooms.</p> <p>The level and nature of support offered in each house will depend on the needs of the people living there.</p> <p>The Scheme offers Gender specific and Cultural Specific support as well as providing support to people with a range of need be it Physical, Cognitive or Behavioural.</p> <p>The Supported living scheme is working toward everyone it supports having a person-centred plan.</p>

<b>Service Description</b>	<p>The Outreach service provides visiting support to people living in their own homes across Oldham to help them to maintain and develop their independence.</p> <p>The type and nature of the accommodation on floating support varies from ground floor, fully accessible, flats to first floor flats and even houses.</p> <p>Housing is accessed through application to “First Choice”, “Selhal”, “West Pennine”, “North British” and several other housing associations.</p> <p>Referral for support is through a “Care Manager” who will assess the individuals needs.</p> <p>Support is given to help maintain tenancies and help people live independently. Community support workers, based in a house geographically close to the persons Tenancy, usually provide this support. As well as housing related support extra support can be offered which more directly relates to a persons care needs (this though is not supporting people fundable). This again is accessed through a “Care Manager” and provided by “Community Support Workers”.</p>
