GATING ORDER NO. 31 2012

SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order;-

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the highways ("the Highways") shown hatched in red on the plans annexed to this Order and described in the first and second columns of the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Highways or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- 3. Gates may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highways. The Community Safety Unit of the Council is responsible for maintaining the gates and their contact number is 0161 770 3000.
- 4. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic (if appropriate) during the period the Highways are restricted is described in the third column of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a black dotted line on the plans annexed to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on 3rd May 2012.

Alleyway to the rear of 75 to 113 Coalshaw Green Road, Chadderton (Plan 1)	The alleyway runs south west to north east for a distance of 87 metres and is 4 metres wide.	Along the side of 75 Coalshaw Green Road, along the front of 75 to 113 Coalshaw Green Road and into Bright Street in both directions


Alleyway to the rear of 192 to 222 Coalshaw Green Road and 2 to 6 Arden Street, Chadderton (Plan 2)	The alleyway runs north to south for a distance of 48 metres and is 3.5 metres wide	Along Regatta Close to Coalshaw Green Road, along the front of 192 to 222 Coalshaw Green Road and then along Arden Street in both directions
Alleyway to the rear of 75 to 105 Wesley Street, 740 to 770 Oldham Road, 1 Norman Street and 2 Mersey Road North, Failsworth (Plan 3)	The alleyway runs south west to north east for a distance of 76 metres and is 3.5 metres wide	Along Oldham Road, into Mersey Road North, into Wesley Street, to Norman Street and back to Oldham Road in both directions
Alleyway to the rear of 55 to 73 Wesley Street and 712 to 738 Oldham Road, Failsworth (Plan 4)	The alleyway runs south west to north east for a distance of 65 metres and is 3.5 metres wide	Along Oldham Road in front of numbers 712 to 738, into Norman Street, into Wesley Street, along Wesley Street in front of numbers 55 to 73 in both directions




PLAN 1


