# ROBINSON STREET AREA, GORTON STREET AND SCHOLES STREET AREA, CHADDERTON GATING ORDER 2012

#### **SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order;-

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the highways ("the Highways") shown hatched in red on the plans annexed to this Order and described in the first and second columns of the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Highways or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- Gates may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highways. The Community Safety Unit of the Council is responsible for maintaining the gates and their contact number is 0161 770 3000.
- 4. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic (if appropriate) during the period the Highways are restricted is described in the third column of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a black dotted line on the plans annexed to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2012.


Chadderton and 23 to 49 Gorton Street Chadderton. (Plan 1)	Street run in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 61 metres and are 3 metres wide.  The alleyway at the side of 31 Bredbury Street runs in an easterly direction for a distance of 9.5 metres and is 3.5 metres wide.  The alleyway to the rear of Jane Street runs west to east for a distance of 27 metres and is 3 metres wide. There is also an unadopted garage area in the middle of these streets, accessed by the alleys. It measures 27 metres by 40 metres.	
The alleyways to the rear of 29 to 45 Robinson Street, Chadderton, 2 to 46 Agnes Street, Chadderton and 1 to 31 Bredbury Street, including the passageway at the side of 31 Bredbury Street.  (Plan 2)	The alleyway to the rear of Robinson Street runs east to west for a distance of 59 metres and is 4 metres wide.  The alleyway to the rear of Agnes Street runs northeast to southwest for a distance of 101 metres and is of variable width from 4 – 11 metres wide.  The alleyway to the rear of Bredbury Street runs north to south for a distance of	Agnes Street, Robinson Street and Bredbury Street and vice versa.

The alleyway to the rear of 24 to 50 Scholes Street, Chadderton. The alleyway to the rear of 62 to 76A (consecutive numbers) Higher House Close, Chadderton and the alleyways running between 20 & 22 Kingston Avenue, Chadderton and 76 and 76A Higher House Close, Chadderton (this is also the route of Public Footpath 57 Chadderton). (Plan 4)	This alleyway runs north east to southwest for a distance of 153 metres. At one end it is 3 metres wide and at the other it is 2.4 metres wide and there is a section part way along that is 23 metres wide.
