## **OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## **HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order;-

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the highway ("the Highway") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Highway or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highway.
- 3. Gates may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highway. The Community Safety Unit of the Council is responsible for maintaining the gates and their contact number is 0161 770 3000.
- 4. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic (if appropriate) during the period the Highway is restricted as described in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a dotted line on the plan annexed to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2010

The alleyway which runs to the rear of 2-14 Piercy Street, Failsworth & 86-96 Ashton Road West, Failsworth.

The alley to the rear of 86-96 Ashton Road West & 2-14 Piercy Street runs in a north easterly direction for a distance of 29.4 metres. The width of the alley is approximately 3 metres.

Piercy Street, West Street, Ashton Road West and Dunkerley Avenue

The alleyway which runs to the rear of 16-34 Densmore Street, Failsworth & 15-31 Piercy Street, Failsworth The alley at the rear of 16-34 Densmore Street & 15-31 Piercy Street runs in a north easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres. The width of the alley is approximately 3.3 metres.

Densmore Street, Cow Lane, Piercy Street and West Street

The alleyways which run at the rear of 2-20 Wellington Street, Failsworth, 15-19 William Street, Failsworth, 10-32 Derby Street, Failsworth & 12-22 Wickentree Lane, Failsworth.

The alley at the rear of 2-20 Wellington Street runs in a south easterly direction for a distance of 49.5 metres. The alley at the rear of 10-32 Derby Street runs in a north westerly direction for a distance of 58.4 metres. The alley at the rear of 12-22 Wickentree Lane runs in a north easterly direction for a distance of 36.4 metres. These alleyways are of variable width ranging

Derby Street, Wickentree Lane, Wellington Street and William Street

The garage forecourt and its associated access to the rear of 157 Jammy Lane, Chadderton & at the gable of 195 Lansdowne Road, Chadderton and the

The Garage Forecourt and its associated access runs in a southerly direction from its junction with Lansdowne Road for a distance of 33 metres with

from 2.7 - 4.0 metres.

Madeley Drive, Block Lane and Lansdowne alleyway at the side of 16 Madeley Drive, Chadderton.

a variable width of 5.5 to 13.7 metres.

The alley at the side of 16 Madeley Drive runs in a westerly direction for a distance of 15.9 metres. The width of the alley is approximately 1.8 metres.

The alleyway which runs to the rear of 1089-1125 Middleton Road, Chadderton, and to the rear and gable of 26-40 Kensington Avenue, Chadderton and at the gable of 1 Saxon Drive, Chadderton

The alley at the rear of 1089-1125 Middleton Road runs in a north westerly direction from a distance of 110 metres. The width of the alley is approximately 4.1 metres

Middleton Road, Saxon Drive, Baytree Avenue and Kensington Avenue.

To include the access to the alleyway at the gables of 1079-1089 Middleton Road. The access at the gables of 1079-1089 Middleton Road runs in a north easterly direction for a distance of 26.2 metres. The width of the alley is approximately 10.3 metres.

The alleyway that runs to the rear of 344-352 Lees Road, Clarksfield and at the gable of 1 Brewerton Road, Clarksfield.

The alley at the rear of 344-352 Lees Road runs in a south easterly direction for a distance of 21 metres. The width of the alley is approximately 3 metres.

Lees Road and Brewerton Road.
