SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

TRENT ROAD, SHAW, OLDHAM GATING ORDER 2009

Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act) and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the pubic right of way over the passage from 83 Trent Road to 2 Eden Way, Shaw ("the Highway") shown edged black on the plan described in Schedule 1 to this Order at any time (available for inspection).
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Highway or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highway.
- Gates may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highway.
 The Community Safety Unit of the Council is responsible for maintaining the gates and their contact number is 0161 770 1573.
- 4. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic (if appropriate) during the period the Highway is restricted is Eden Way, Alwin Road, Derwent Drive and Trent Road in both directions and is shown by a dotted line on the plan annexed to this Order (available for inspection).
- 5. This Order shall take effect on 17th February 2010.
