2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at 1 Spinks Street, Oldham, OL4 1DW as shown edged red on the accompanying plan ("the Land")

3 THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission the erection of a 'box style' dormer that spans the front and rear elevations of the property on the Land.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years. The dormer by reason of its size, scale, appearance, design and prominent setting, relates poorly and detracts from the appearance of this property and is an intrusive and discordant feature in the street scene which is harmful to the visual amenities of the area. The proposal is, therefore, contrary to Policy D1.1 (House Extensions) of the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Unitary Development Plan.

WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Permanently remove the 'box style' dormer and make good the roof to match existing materials.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

The actions specified in 5 above must be carried out within three months of this notice taking effect.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

The Notice takes effect on 5th December 2011, unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

Failure to comply with an Enforcement Notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.

The fee for the deemed planning permission application is £300 half of which is payable to the Council and half to the Department for Communities and Local Government. There is no fee for the appeal itself.
