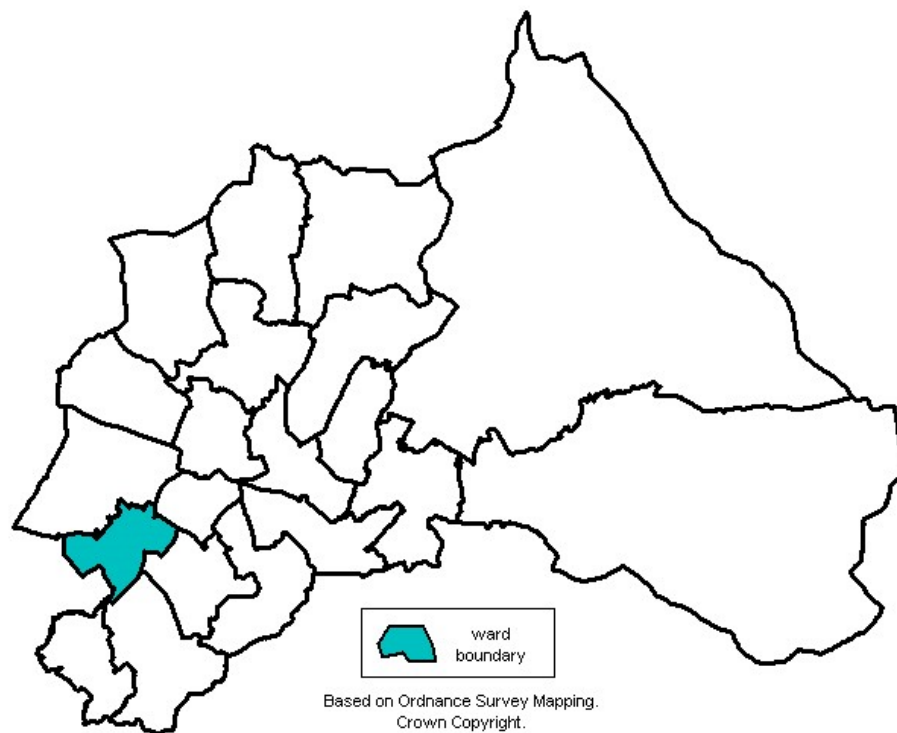
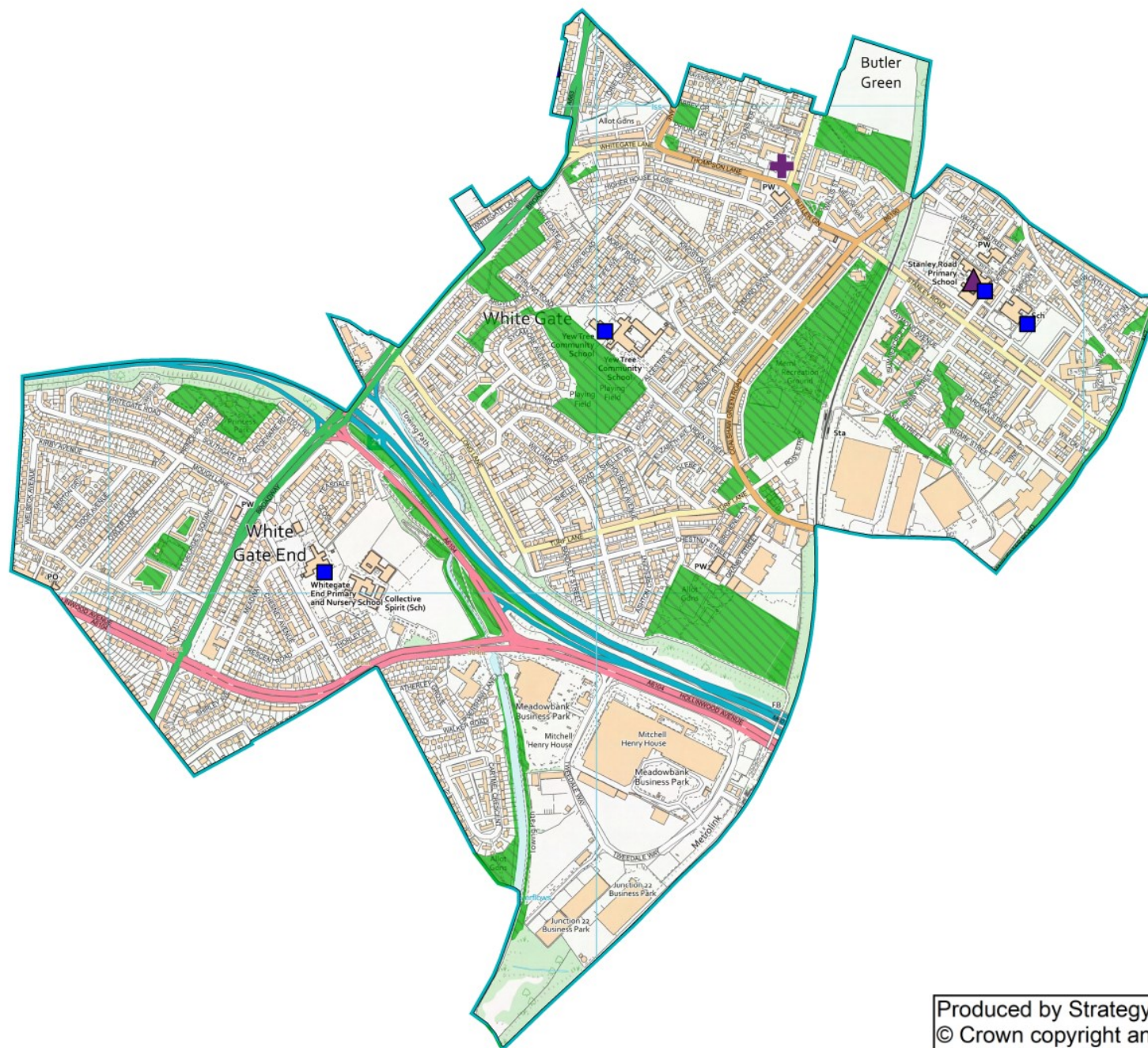

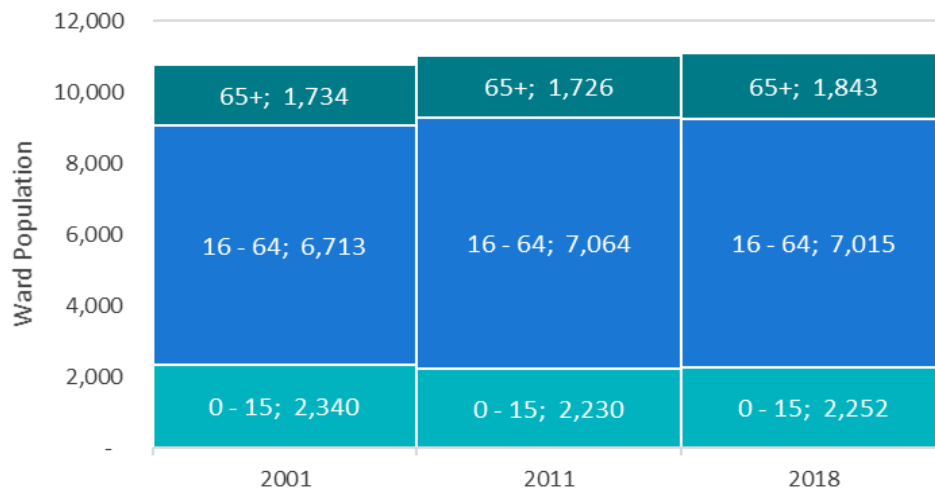


- Chadderton South's population decreased slightly between 2011 and 2018. This compares to the Oldham wide average increase of 3.9%.
- There is a high proportion of White residents within the ward (91%). Both Pakistani and Bangladeshi communities show increasing numbers, but both are far below the Oldham average.

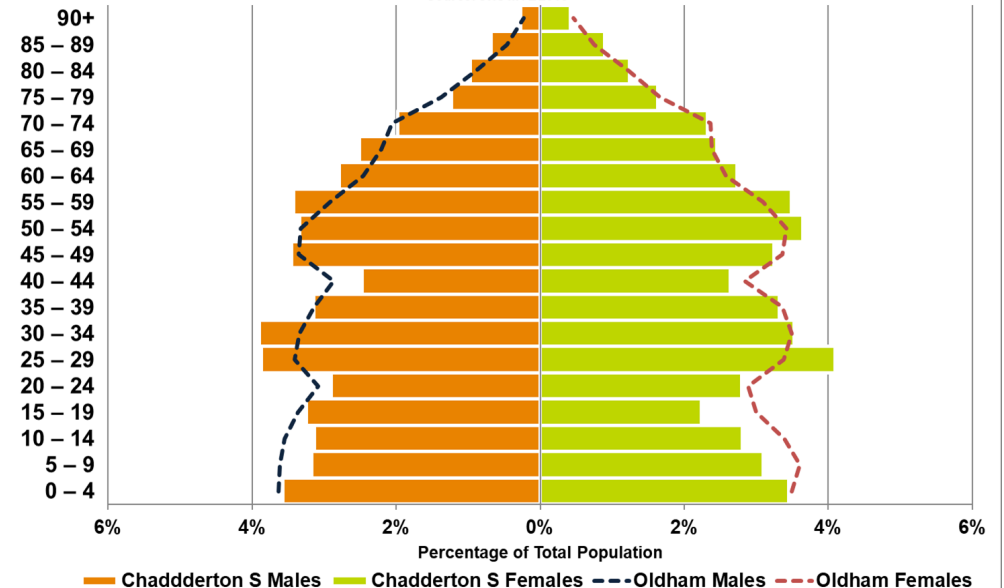

- A slightly lower proportion of people are on Out of Work Benefits in Chadderton South (10.8%) than in Oldham as a whole (11.0%).

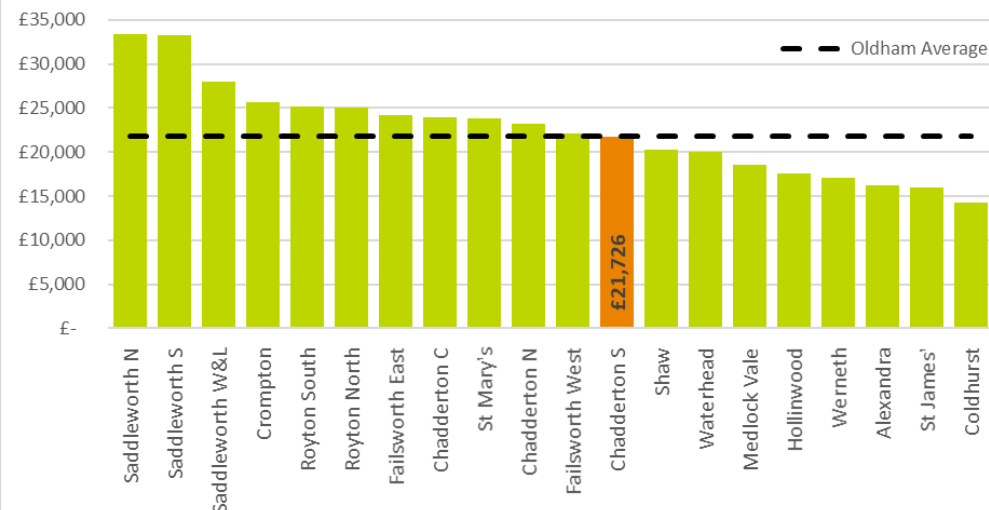

- The average sold house price in Chadderton South is 18% lower than the Oldham average.

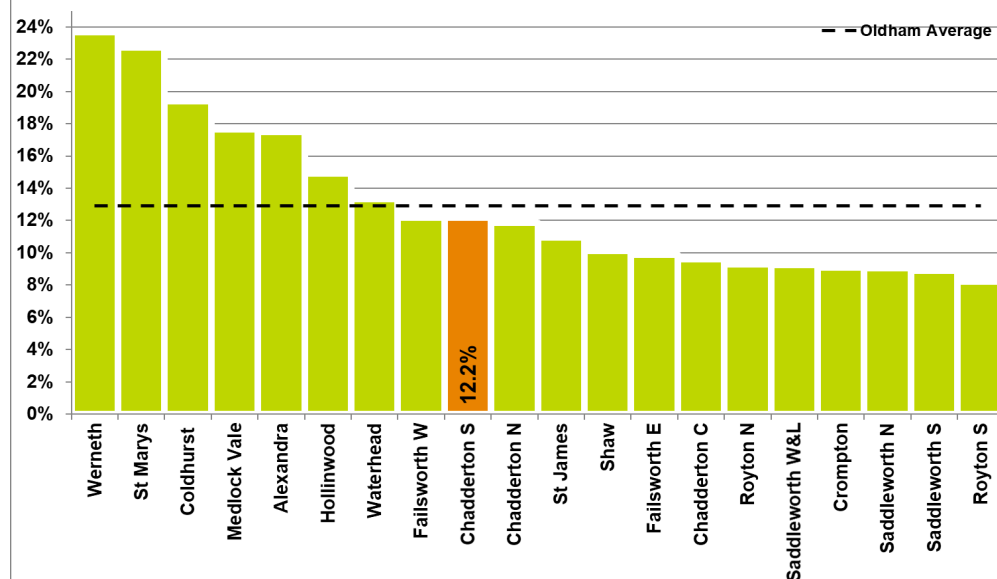

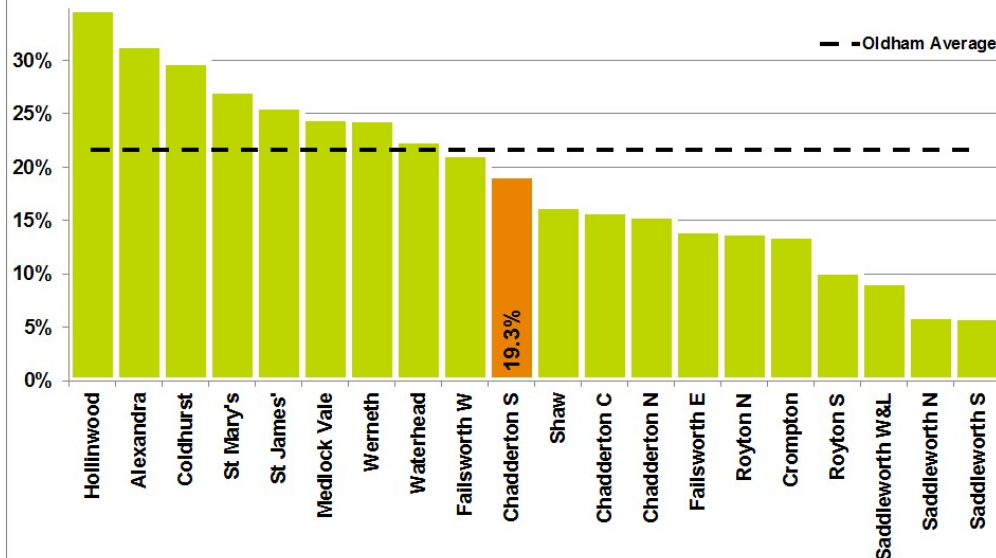
- Chadderton South has a similar proportion of single person households (30.7%) as the Oldham average (30.3%).
- The proportion of lone parent households in the ward (14.1%) is slightly higher than the Oldham average (13.1%).
- The proportion of households overcrowded in the ward (6.3%) is slightly lower than the Oldham average (7.5%).

- 73.9% of pupils in Chadderton South leave the Early Years Foundation stage with a Good Level of Development. This compares to 68.1% in Oldham as a whole.
- 55.6% of pupils attain Grade 4 or above in English and Maths GCSE, compared with 56.1% in Oldham as a whole.
- 4.8% of pupils gain no GCSE passes, compared with 2.7% in Oldham as a whole.

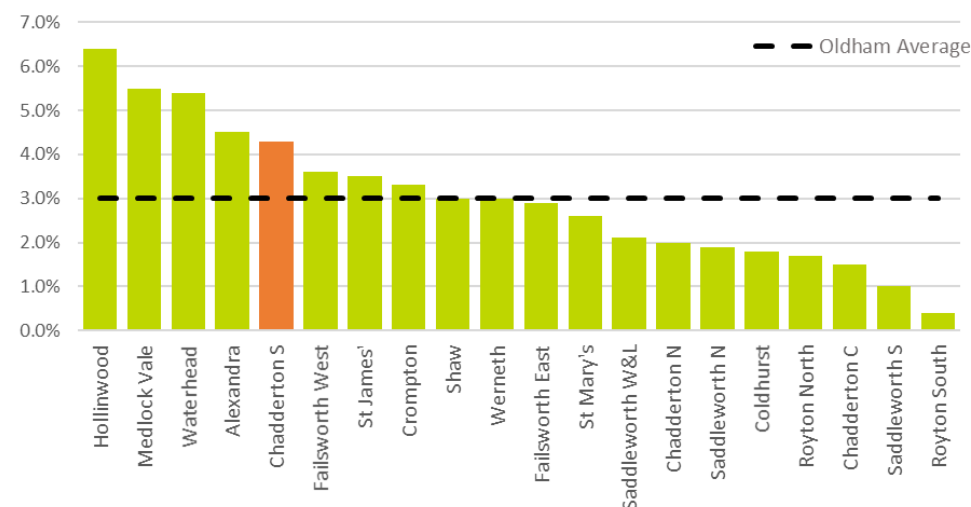

- Chadderton South's Male Life Expectancy (78.3 years) is slightly higher than the Oldham wide average for males (77.2 years).
- Chadderton South's Female Life Expectancy (81.9 years) is slightly higher than the Oldham wide average for females (80.9 years).
- A slightly lower proportion of Year 6 children (22.7%) are obese than in Oldham as a whole (23.4%). Breastfeeding rates are not good.

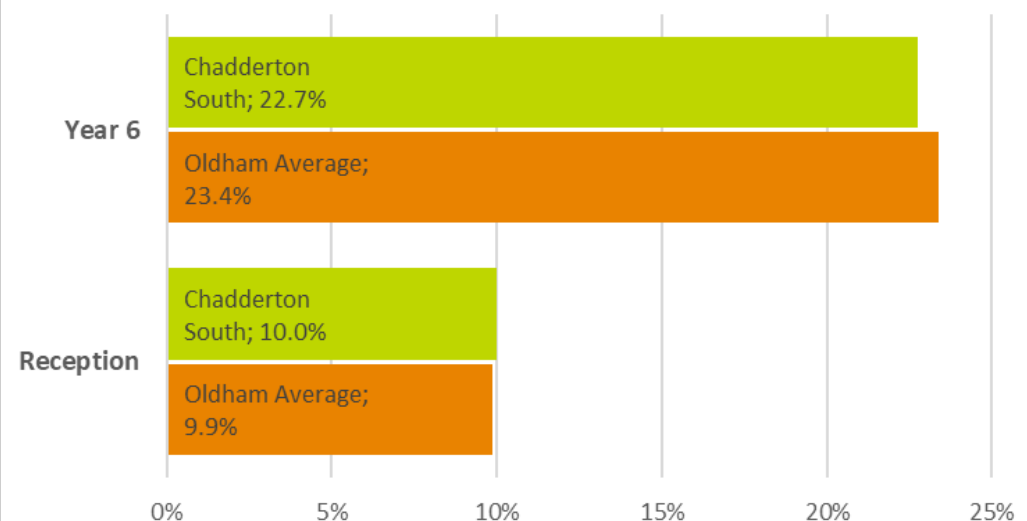

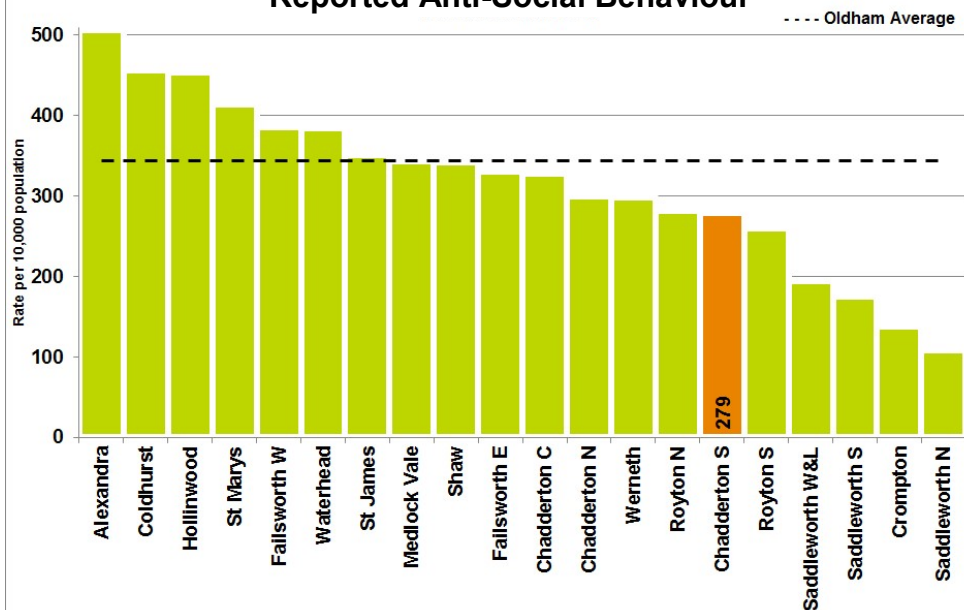
Road Traffic Accidents

- Chadderton South's rate of reported Anti-Social Behaviour is lower than the average for the borough.
- The overall rate of reported crimes is higher than the Oldham average.
- Police intelligence suggests a fall in the rate of reporting. New crime recording standards have changed the classification of certain offences, meaning we can't compare over time.

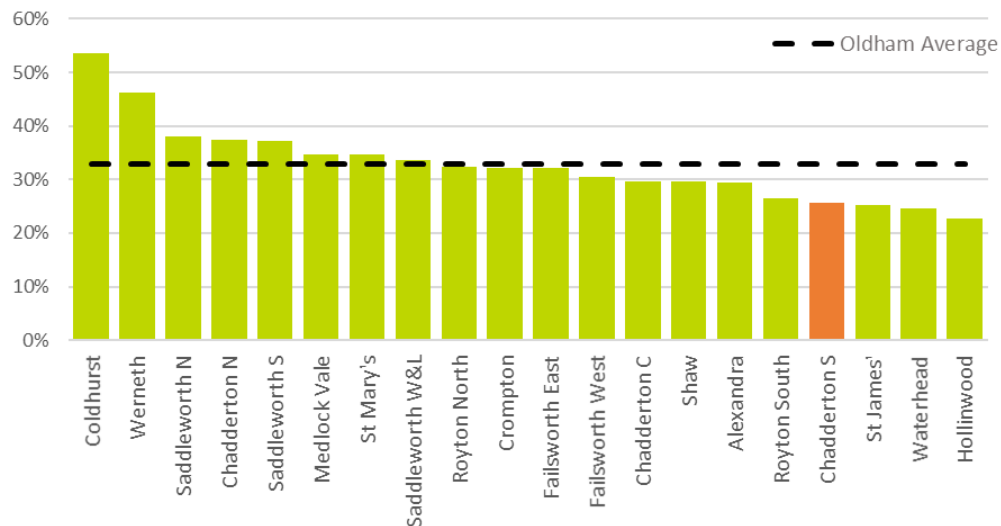

Chadderton South is a built up area and housing developments that are currently taking place at Granby St (former Emanuel Church site), Rose St (former Rose Mill site) and on Stanley Road (former Stanley Road Sports & Social Club) are bringing much needed new housing to the area. Developments include homes suitable for the elderly or less mobile (bungalows), rented properties, and privately owned homes.

There are two parks in the ward; Coalshaw Green Park and Princess Park, with the former boasting the most modern skate park in the borough, while the multi-use games area has also had a complete make-over in the last couple of years. Princess Park has had a play area for the youngest of residents installed in recent years.

Chadderton South is the only ward in Chadderton that isn't home to a high school, but it does have three primary schools which perform well. Work has been undertaken to improve on the environmental scene with planters in place on Hollinwood Avenue and Coalshaw Green Road, while bulb planting has taken place in other areas. Splitting the ward almost geographically in half is the M60 and has Junction 21 connecting the wider Oldham borough to the orbital motorway around Manchester and in close conjunction the M62.
