- 1. A building materials shall not be deposited on the highway unless and until written permission has been obtained from the local authority.
- 2. The person to whom any permission has been granted shall ensure: -
 - (a) that the material is properly fenced and during the hours of darkness be properly lighted;
 - (b) that the conditions in the licence regarding positioning and clear access are complied with;
 - (c) that the area is cleaned and reinstated where necessary on completion;
 - (d) the materials are removed as soon as possible at least on or before the expiry of the licence:

a person who fails to comply with Conditions is liable to a fine not exceeding £10 per day in which the contravention or failure occurs.

- 3. This application form, when completed, should be submitted to the Environmental Services Department at Henshaw House, Cheapside, Oldham OL1 1NY (Tel: 0161 911 4363) together with the application fee of £39.00.
- 4. In order to minimise inconvenience, applicants are warned that repeat application may be refused.
- 5. The applicants attention is drawn to Highways Act 1980 Section 170 Control of mixing mortar etc on Highways which makes it an offence to mix or deposit on a highway any mortar, cement or other substance which is likely to stick on a highway or solidify in drains or sewers
