

Oldham Council Community Call-in

Oldham Council Community Call-in allows local residents to challenge a decision taken by their District Executive. If a decision is successfully called-in it is put on hold while Oldham Council's Overview and Scrutiny review the decision and make recommendations.

Overview and Scrutiny may choose to make no recommendations, in which case the decision is enacted as normal.

Decisions relating to planning and licencing are exempt from Community Call-in. This is because these decisions are covered by national legislation the council must adhere to.

To Call-in a decision by a District Executive requires 100 signatures from residents of the District Executive area. This requirement is lowered to 50 signatures if the call in is sponsored by a Ward Member of an effected ward.

The petition must be sent to Oldham Council Overview and Scrutiny within ten days of the District Executive minutes being published.
