OLDHAM GATING ORDER 36 2013

SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order;-

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the highways ("the Highways") shown hatched in red on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule 1 to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Highways or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- 3. Gates may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highways. The Community Safety Unit of the Council is responsible for maintaining the gates and their contact number is 0161 770 3000.
- 4. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic (if appropriate) during the period the Highways are restricted is described in Schedule 2 to this Order and shown by a dotted line on the plans annexed to this Order.
- 5. This order shall take effect on 21st October 2013.



The alleyway that runs to the rear of 2-18 Widdop Street runs in a westerly direction for a distance of 40.8 metres and is approximately 3.3 metres wide.	The alternate route is along the front of 2-26 Neath Street, into Hilda Street and into Westbourne Street along the front of numbers 39-15 and into Widdop Street along the front of numbers 2-18, both directions.
The alleyway that runs to the rear of 25-53 Osborne Street, Oldham. (Plan 3)	The alleyway that runs to the rear of 25-53 Osborne Street runs in a north westerly direction for a distance of 69.6 metres and is approximately 3.2 metres at the rear of number 25 and 5.8 metres at the rear of number 53.	The alternate route is along the front of 25-53 Osborne Street, both directions.
The alleyway that runs to the rear of 2-42 St Hilda's Drive, 21-51 Mitchell Street, 1-19 Ripon Street and to the rear of 114-130 Ward Street, Oldham. (Plan 4)	The alleyway that runs to the rear of 2-28 St Hilda's Drive and 21-51 Mitchell Street runs in a West direction for a distance of 70 metres and is approximately 3.3 metres at the rear of number 2 and 2 metres at the rear of number 28. The alleyway that runs to the rear of 30-42 St Hilda's Drive and 1-19 Ripon Street runs in a south westerly direction for a distance of 41.5 metres and is approximately 3.2	The alternate route is along Sheraton Road, along the front of numbers 1-29 and along the side of 29 Sheraton Road and 60 Manley Road and into Manley Road, along the front of numbers 60-34 and the side of 34 Manley Road and 1 Sheraton Road, both directions.

The alleyway that runs to the rear of 1-21 Hurst Street and 30-50 Plato Street, Oldham. (Plan 5)	metres. The alleyway that runs to the rear of 3- 21 Malton Street, 1- Jamia Mosque Ross Street and 20-40 Werneth Hall Road. (Plan 6)	The alleyway that runs to the rear of 3-21 Malton Street runs in a westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres and is approximately 3 metres wide. The alleyway that runs to the rear of 1-Jamia Mosque Ross Street runs in a south easterly direction for a distance of 21.7 metres and is approximately 4.5 metres wide.	Street, both directions. The alternate route is along the front of numbers 3-21 Malton Street and into Ross Street along the front of number 1-9 and along the front of the Jamia Mosque and into Werneth Hall Road along the front of the Jamia Mosque and into Werneth Hall Road along the front of numbers 40-20, both directions.

The alleyway that runs between 20 & 32 Villa Road, Oldham. (Plan 7)	The alleyway that runs between 20 & 32 Villa Road runs in a south easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres and is approximately 2.8 metres wide.	The alternate route is along the front of property numbers 22-44 Villa Road and along the side of number 44 Villa Road to the rear of the properties, both directions.




