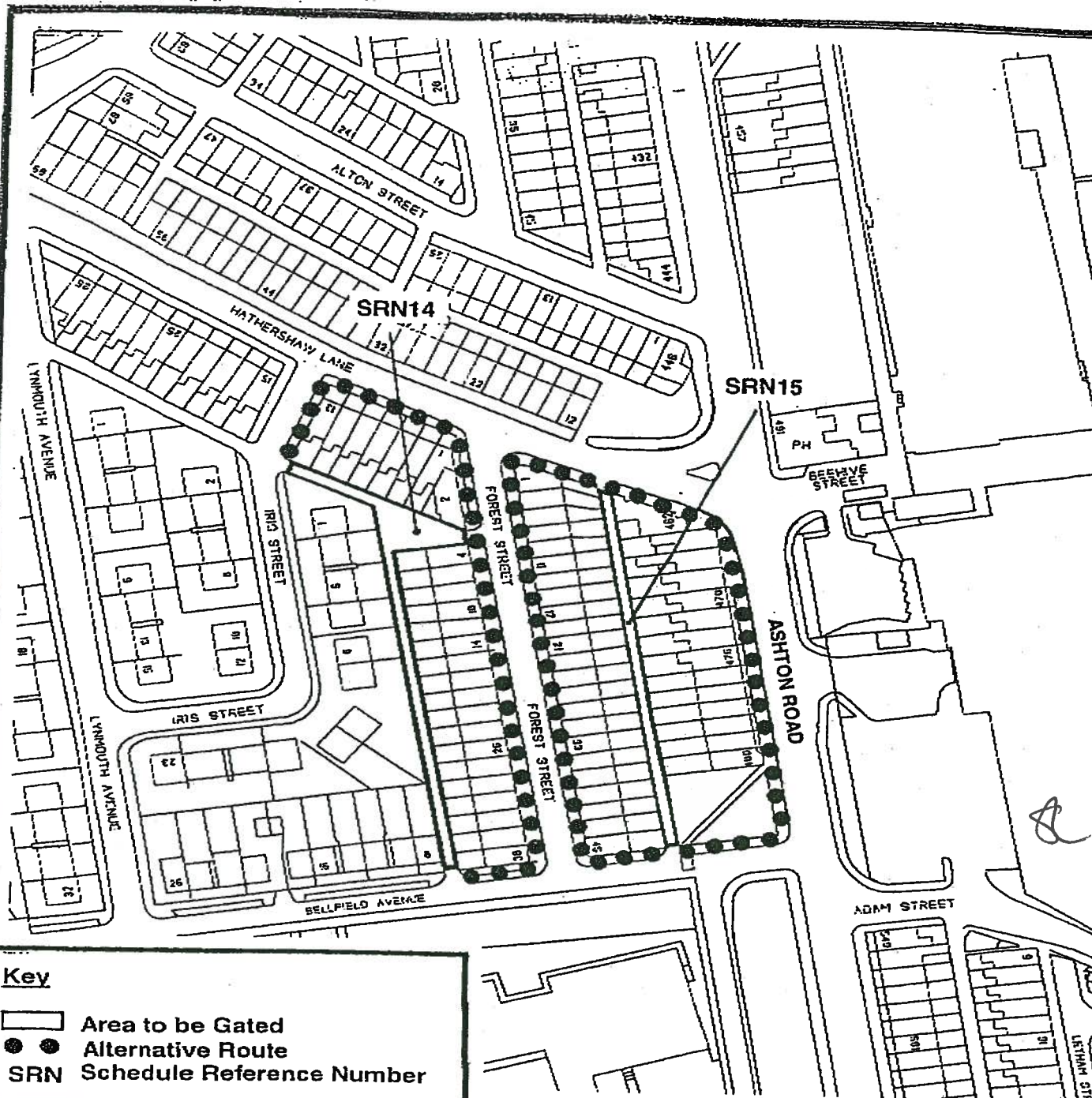
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order;-

1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the highway (“the Highway”) shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Highway or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highway.
3. Gates may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highway. The Community Safety Unit of the Council is responsible for maintaining the gates and their contact number is 0161 770 3000.
4. The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic (if appropriate) during the period the Highway is restricted as described in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a dotted line on the plan annexed to this Order.
5. This Order shall take effect on 11th April 2007

SCHEDULE

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Alternative Route</u>
Passage at the rear of 4 – 38 Forest Street, Hathershaw including the passageway to the rear of 2 Forest Street and 1 – 13 Hathershaw Lane.	The passage commences on Iris Street at the rear of 13 Hathershaw Lane and extends for a distance of 42m in a generally south easterly direction and varies in width between 3m and 13m, then from the rear of 4 Forest Street the passage extends in a southerly direction for a distance of 82m in a southerly direction and has a width of 3m.	Bellfield Avenue, Forest Street, Hathershaw Lane, Iris Street and vice versa.
Passage to the rear of 1 – 45 Forest Street, Hathershaw.	The passage commences on Hathershaw Lane at the rear of 1 Forest Street and extends for a distance of 93m in a southerly direction and has a width varying between 2m and 3m.	Bellfield Avenue, Ashton Road, Hathershaw Lane, Forest Street and vice versa.
