NOTICE OF PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

PEXWOOD AND ROOKWOOD, CHADDERTON

Notice is hereby given that Oldham Borough Council ('the Council') proposes for the purposes of reducing crime and antisocial behaviour to make a Public Spaces Protection Order under Section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to restrict the public right of way over the highways listed in the Schedule ("the Restricted Areas") and also to impose the following restrictions:

1. No waste or household item shall be deposited, stored or discarded in the Restricted Areas. This restriction shall not apply to any wheeled bin or other receptacle for the storage of waste where the Council has given written consent for the wheeled bin or receptacle to be stored in the Restricted Areas.
2. A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time in the Restricted Areas he does not keep the dog on a lead.
3. If a dog defecates at any time in the Restricted Areas and a person who is in charge of the dog at the time fails to remove the faeces from the Restricted Areas forthwith, that person shall be guilty of an offence.

The Order will contain exemptions for any person who lives in premises adjoining the Restricted Areas, emergency services personnel, statutory undertakers and utility providers.

A draft of the proposed Order together with plans is available for inspection on the Council's website and also at Civic Centre Reception, West Street, Oldham, Chadderton Library and Wellbeing Centre, Burnley Street, Chadderton and Chadderton Town Hall, Middleton Road, Chadderton between the hours of 8.40am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday telephone 0161 770 3019 (Ref AE/GO/37).

Any representation or objection to the proposed Public Spaces Protection Order must be in writing addressed to the Director of Legal Services, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham OL1 1UL stating the highway to which they relate and the grounds for making them before 20 April 2015.

Restricted Areas

<u>Location</u>	<u>Description</u>
The footpath that runs between 5 and 6 Pexwood, Chadderton (Plan 1)	The footpath runs in a southerly direction for a distance of 26.2 metres and is approximately 1.84 metres wide at its widest point.
The footpath that runs between 7 and 8 Rookwood Chadderton (which is definitive footpath 25A) (Plan 2)	The footpath runs in a north westerly direction for 26.91 metres and is approximately 1.78 metres wide at its widest point.
