Oldham's Local Offer provides clear, comprehensive, accessible and up-to-date information about what services are available and how to access them.

Oldham's Local Offer includes information on:

- Special Educational Needs provision provided by every school in Oldham, whether they are a mainstream or specialist school.
- Specialist school provision outside the Oldham area where this is being used by local children with SEND.
- How Education, Health and Care plan needs assessments are carried out in Oldham.
- Teaching approaches including how the curriculum will be adapted, arrangements for assessment and monitoring, how effectiveness will be measured and extra-curricular activities children and young people can access.
- · How Special Educational Needs (SEN) are identified.
- Employment and training opportunities.
- Health care services, which includes speech and language therapy and mental health services.
- · Social care provision.
- · How to find childcare providers.
- Support available to children and young people to help them prepare for adulthood.
- School transport.
- · Information, advice and support services.
- · Local support groups.

- How to give feedback including complaints and compliments.
- Any eligibility criteria that may apply to any of the provision set out in Oldham's Local Offer.
