# 3. THE RELEVANT PLANNING PERMISSION

The relevant planning permission to which this notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2019 for the erection of a three storey teaching block over existing multi use games area (MUGA) with associated soft and hard landscaping, construction of a multi use games area (MUGA) to rear of existing sports hall and associated soft and hard landscaping, the erection of a single storey extension to Clegg block 4, internal remodelling to existing Selwyn and Milne Block, demolition of existing Ballard teaching block and removal of existing MUGA and the creation of two new car parking areas Ref PA/341768/18.

## 4. THE BREACH OF CONDITION

The following condition has not been complied with:

#### Condition 27

During construction and demolition, no vehicular movements from construction vehicles to and from and/or within the site shall take place except between 07:30 and 18.00 hours each day, Monday to Saturday, and at no times on Sundays or Bank Holidays and Public Holidays.

Reason - To protect the amenity of occupiers of nearby properties.

# 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

As the person responsible for the breach of condition specified in paragraph 4 of this notice, you are required to comply with the stated condition by taking the following steps, namely to cease the movement and operation of construction vehicles to and from and /or within the site on Sundays.


