

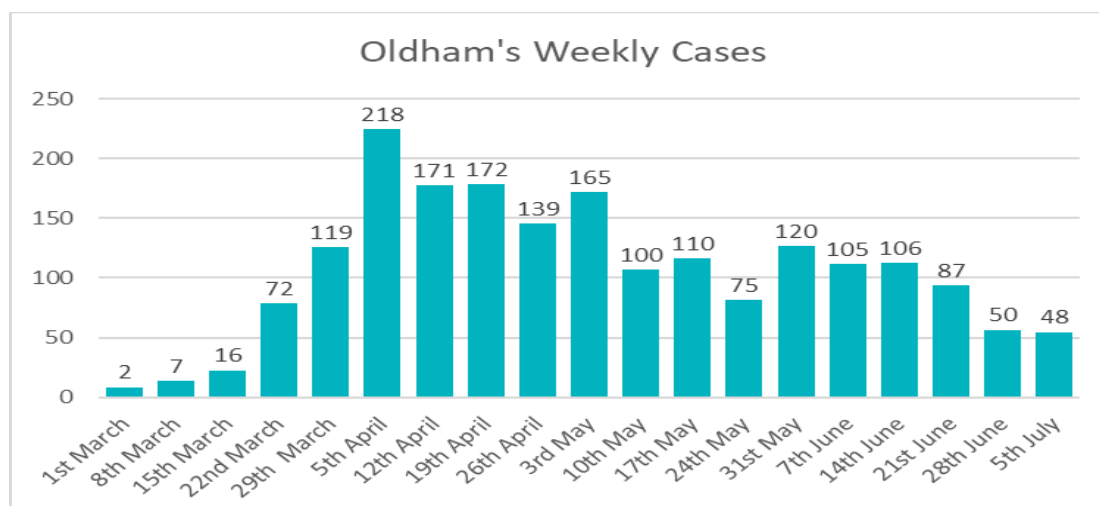
Covid-19 Weekly Surveillance Tracker

COVID-19 Cases

The most recent information available (i.e. 29th June – 5th July) shows that Oldham has had 48 new cases identified. At population level the number is equivalent to a rate of 20.2 per 100,000 population in Oldham, which is the second highest rate across Greater Manchester and higher than the England rate.

Over the period of the pandemic the weekly number of cases have been reducing since week beginning the 31st May and are now the lowest since mid-March (see the figure below). The total number of confirmed cases in Oldham now totals 1,882, a rate of 799 per 100,000 population, the highest rate across Greater Manchester.



Deaths from COVID-19

In total, there has been a total of 257 COVID-19 deaths to Oldham residents over entire period of the pandemic, with two deaths registered over the last week. This has reduced from 4 the previous week.
