#### What the webinar is about

Research shows that autistic people are significantly more likely to think about, attempt, and die by suicide than the general population. Although the numbers were small, the National Child Mortality Database recently found that a quarter of children who died by suicide immediately before and after the national COVID-19 lockdown, were autistic or had ADHD.

This webinar will summarise the latest evidence on suicide and autism and discuss some of the steps that children and young people's crisis services can take to be more accessible to young autistic people and their families. This webinar aimed at people managing or commissioning children's crisis services. There is an earlier webinar on 27<sup>th</sup> October geared towards people working or volunteering in crisis services
