Title – Statement of Community Involvement (SCI)

Subject Matter - This Adoption Statement gives notice that Oldham Council has resolved to adopt the SCI on 9 September 2020.

The SCI outlines when and how we will engage the community in the preparation of the Local Plan and other planning documents. It outlines how we will provide guidance and assistance to neighbourhood planning groups. It also sets out how the community will be consulted on planning applications.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of this decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SCI was adopted.

Date of adoption – 9 September 2020

Area covered by the document - Whole borough, except the part that falls within the Peak District National Park.
