Replacement trees should have a minimum girth (circumference round the trunk) of 12-14 cm. measured one metre from ground level.

Most of the above trees are available in containers and can be planted at any time of year subject to plentiful watering in dry spells.

Trees should be planted in the same position as the felled tree or as may otherwise be agreed with the Council.
