

# **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

## **THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (NORTH WEST) (NO. ) ORDER 20..**

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

1. The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highways described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the plan numbered NATTRAN/NW/S247/5531, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by Oldham Council under reference FUL/349659/22.
2. The developer shall to the reasonable satisfaction of Oldham Council provide improvement of the highways as proposed and detailed in the approved planning permission, development plans and associated legal agreements with the Council.
3. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.

### **THE SCHEDULE**

#### **Description of highways to be stopped up**

The highways to be stopped up are at Shaw in the Borough of Oldham, shown on the plan and are;

1. An irregular shaped area of unnamed highway as lies east of Westway. It commences from grid reference E:393790 N:408814 and extends in a north easterly direction for a distance of 25.5 metres and having a maximum width of 7.1 metres.
2. An irregular shaped area of unnamed highway as lies east of Westway. It commences from grid reference E:393809 N:408780 and extends in a north easterly direction for 26.9 metres and having a maximum width of 9.8 metres.
