PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53A(2)

OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (FOOTPATHS 61 OLDHAM) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

This order is made by Oldham Borough Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part 3 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely FUL/351218/23 – demolition of gas holder, erection of employment development comprising 5 units (Use Class E(g)(ii)(iii)/B2/B8 uses) with ancillary E(g)(i) office space, car parking and vehicular, pedestrian circulation with access onto Olive Claydon Way, Hollinwood, Oldham.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted and the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map and statement shall be modified as described below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Oldham Borough Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Oldham Borough Council certify that the terms of paragraph 2 above have been complied with and upon the occurrence of the diversion the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it the path or way referred to in paragraph 1 of this order and the path or way referred to in paragraph 2 of this order shall be added to it, and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose

of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1 Description of site of existing path or way

Part of Footpath 61 Oldham commencing on Olive Claydon Way, Hollinwood at point A (GR SD90701 02310) proceeding in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 276 metres to point B (GR SD90746 02038) where the path crosses Roman Road and continues south on its existing alignment as shown on the attached map.

PART 2 Description of site of alternative highway

Part of Footpath 61 Oldham commencing at point C on Olive Claydon Way, Hollinwood (GR SD90698 02307) proceeding in a southwesterly direction along the gravel path for a distance of approximately 44 metres to point D (GR SD90665 02284) then proceeding in a generally southerly direction along the western boundary of the industrial site for a distance of approximately 267 metres to point E (GR SD90704 02037) then proceeding in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 47 metres to point B (GR SD90746 02038) to cross Roman Road and proceeding south on its existing alignment as shown on the attached map.
