PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 44 SADDLEWORTH) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2015

This order is made by Oldham Borough Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Council that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The owner of the land has agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Council that the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Castlehill Cote, Cote Lane, Castleshaw, Saddleworth, Oldham and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Castlehill Cote, Cote Lane, Castleshaw, Saddleworth, Oldham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order and thereupon the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- 3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
- 4. The Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

Footpath 44 Saddleworth from point A (OS Map Reference 399639 409406) located 15 metres north westerly from the access road to Castleshaw Lower Reservoir then in a north easterly direction to point B (OS Map Reference 399654 409426) at the southern end of Dry Croft Lane.


DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

From point C, the pedestrian gate in the masonry wall on Cote Lane (OS Map Reference 399649 409397) located opposite the access road to Castleshaw Lower Reservoir in a north easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres to point D (OS Map Reference 399659 409406) and then north north westerly for a distance of 14 metres to point B (OS Map Reference 399654 409426) at the southern end of Dry Croft Lane.
